# CRAP OR SLAP! RULES

## **BOX CONTENTS:**

250 cards - Situations on top, Reactions on bottom These Rules

## SET-UP:

- Remove the cards and place in several stacks on the table.
- Choose a player to be the active player first.

- Each player takes 5 cards. You may look at the cards.

## GAME PLAY:

Round 1:

- The active player picks a situation (top of each card), reads it aloud and places it face up in front of them.

- All other players choose a reaction (bottom of card) from their hand and places it in front of the active player face down.

- The active player shuffles the face down cards, flips each one over reading it aloud and picks their favorite reaction to the situation they played.

- The played situation is given to the player who contributed the chosen reaction, and it is placed face up in front of them.

All reaction cards are discarded and each player draws a card.
Active player is now the player to the left of the previous active player.

- Round 1 continues until one player has obtained half the required cards to win. These cards are face up in front of the players after their reactions were chosen.

## Round 2:

- The active player picks a reaction, reads it aloud and places it face up in front of them.

- All other players choose a situation from their hand and places it in front of the active player face down.

- The active player shuffles the face down cards, flips each one over reading it aloud and picks their favorite reaction to the situation they played.

- The played reaction is given to the player who contributed the chosen situation, and it is placed face up in front of them.

All situation cards are discarded and each player draws a card.
Active player is now the player to the left of the previous active player.

## WINNING THE GAME:

3-5 players - 8 cards 5-7 players - 6 cards 8-10 players - 4 cards

**TWO PLAYER GAME:** Deal a mock hand to the side. Treat this as a third player, but the cards are chosen randomly. The mock hand will flip over a card when they are the active player. The mock hand will contribute a card when they are not the active player. When they draw a new card, it goes to the bottom of their hand. They will win cards just as if they were a player. When someone gets 8 cards, the game is over. If the mock hand gets 8 cards, they win (sad but true).

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
